JakLingko MaaS Super App officially deployed to the public

After weeks of testing, it's finally D-day! This Thursday, June 23, 2022, Jakarta's public transport authorities officially launch their MaaS Super App Jaklingko.

From multimodal trip search to payment and booking, Jaklingko, Lyko's client aims to cover the needs of more than 30 million users in the megacity. Besides mobility, other services will also be available on the platform.

As part of a project to deploy and operate a MaaS solution in the city of Jakarta, the Jaklingko application will now provide users with better access to public transport. Available on the Appstore and Playstore, the application covers all journeys, from the first to the last mile.

On the technical side, the design and deployment of the Jaklingko service was carried out by the Jatel consortium, composed of PT Jatelindo, PT Aino, Thales and Lyko. For its part, Lyko is providing, for the next 8 years, its API platform that will allow the user interface to be connected to the distribution systems of thousands of transport operators, as well as to the intermodal trip calculator.

« This is a new superapp, which will be used for all transportation in Jakarta. Where to go, what route, what vehicle, where to make a connection, how far to travel, all in one app. Train, MRT, bus, angkot, even Grab will be there.
